Founded in 1918, the International Institute of New England (IINE) is one of the oldest and largest social service organizations for new Americans in the region. Each year, we serve nearly 2,000 refugee, asylee, and immigrant clients across our three sites in Boston and Lowell, MA, and Manchester, NH.

The "Lowell 100" is a celebration of IINE's centennial anniversary in our founding city and will send a clear message that America - and Lowell - is still a welcoming place. As part of the event, we will honor 100 immigrants and allies of immigrants who have had a significant impact on Lowell. This is an opportunity to celebrate the immigrant community, the city of Lowell, and IINE's 100 years of service.

UMass Professor Robert Forrant, an expert on the history of Lowell, will present an IINE timeline exhibit he and his students have been developing.

INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF NEW FNGLAND IN LOWELL - AN OVERVIEW

HISTORY

Founded in Lowell in 1918, the International Institute of New England (IINE) is one of the oldest and largest social service organizations for new Americans in the region. Each year, we serve nearly 2,000 refugee, asylee, and immigrant clients across our three sites in Boston and Lowell, MA, and Manchester, NH. The Lowell site was originally founded in response to an influx of European immigrants into the Greater Merrimack Valley after WWI.

The International Institute of Boston was founded shortly thereafter in 1924, while Manchester established its

operations in 1987. In 2009, the sites consolidated into the International Institute of New England.

At the core of the IINE community is the belief that every immigrant and refugee welcomed to our shores is an investment in our country and our communities. Immigrants renew the American identity. invigorate our economy, and preserve and testify to our commitment to fairness and equality.



PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- RECEPTION AND PLACEMENT The core work of IINE-Lowell involves resettling refugees who are fleeing persecution and conflict in their homelands. We also support asylees who seek political protection after arriving in the U.S.
- ENGLISH INSTRUCTION Our English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) program provides English language classes to more than 50 foreign-born students each year. Our contextualized vocational ESOL classes rapidly equip students with the language skills and cultural knowledge needed to enter the workforce or advance their careers.
- SPECIALIZED VOCATIONAL TRAINING Our new Creating New Avenues for Success (CNA for Success) program prepares Lowell-area immigrants who are interested in pursuing careers in healthcare with the comprehensive skills training and contextualized English instruction to become Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs).
- LEGAL IMMIGRATION FORMS SERVICE (LIFS) Given the federal government's ramped-up deportation and efforts to restrict immigration, trustworthy and affordable immigration assistance is more important than ever. Each successful form represents an important step in an immigrant individual or family's pathway to citizenship.
- **REFUGEE EMPLOYMENT SERVICES (RES)** IINE-Lowell provides employment services for up to five years from an individual's date of arrival, enabling IINE to continue helping refugees and asylees further develop their skills, obtain better-paying positions and advance their careers.
- RESEARCH & IMPACT ASSESSMENT although refugee resettlement agencies operate in every state, very little research has been conducted to determine which resettlement activities or practices are most beneficial to the long-term self-sufficiency and integration of refugees. Based in our Lowell office, IINE's new research initiative produces critical data for the refugee resettlement community that will inform best practices in coming years.
